## PLEASE PURCHASE THE FOLLOWING OVER-THE-COUNTER SUPPLIES AT YOUR LOCAL PHARMACY:

Nulytely/Colyte/Golytely (Prescription required - please obtain from your GI provider)

Two (2) Dulcolax® tablets or its generic version

One (1) 10 oz. bottle of Magnesium Citrate (NO RED)

THE DAY PRIOR TO YOUR PROCEDURE. Day:	Date:
	<b>S ALLOWED:</b> Water, black coffee, apple and white grape
juice, soda, tea, Kool Aid, sports drinks, lemon or lin	ne Jell-O, chicken or beef broth, and popsicles.
NOT ALLOWED: Solid food, milk, alco	hol, or anything RED, ORANGE OR PURPLE.
STEP 1 flavored Crystal Lig pour into the bottle	packets if they were dispensed with your prep or add lemon tht or Kool Aid. If adding flavor, tear open flavor pack and be before mixing. Add lukewarm water to top line on bottle. Shake to dissolved the powder. Refridgerate the bottle.
STEP 2 until you fi movement	Drink one (1) <b>8 oz.</b> glass of mixture every 10-15 minutes nish the entire gallon of the mixture. The first bowel should begin approximately 1 hour after starting the prep. rink <b>ALL</b> of the solution.
LAXATIVE TABLETS	<b>PM,</b> Take two (2) Dulcolax tablets with <b>8 oz.</b> of water. the tablets whole with a full glass of water.
	u have not had a bowel movement or your stools are not  1) <b>10 oz.</b> bottle of Magnesium citrate.

\*\*Stay near toilet. You will have diarrhea, which can be quite sudden. This is normal. The stool should eventually be a clear yellow liquid. No food, drink, or water after 3:30 AM or \_\_\_\_\_.\*\*

**AT LEAST A WEEK BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE.** Check with your prescribing doctor to make sure it is safe to hold prescription blood thinners, such as Cousmadin, Plavix, Pradaxa, Xarelto, Warfarin, Eliquis, or iron supplements. Please get permission to stop these **4 days prior** to your procedure.

#### **COLON CLEANSING TIPS:**

**Drink solution chilled.** 

Drink sips of the solution through a straw.

Walking will help move the solution through your body.

If you feel bloated or your stomach feels "full", drink solution slowly.

Continue drinking lots of clear liquids until midnight.

Anal skin irritation or flare of hemorrhoid inflammation may occur. If this happens, treat it with over-the-counter remedies, such as hydrocortisone cream, baby wipes, Vaseline® or Tucks® – avoid products containing alcohol.

**NPO STATUS:** During your procedure you will be administered either general anesthesia or heavy sedation. For your safety, it is essential you follow these guidelines:

- No GUM, CANDY, MINTS, CIGARETTE SMOKING or TOBACCO USE 2 hours prior to your arrival time.
- NOTHING TO EAT OR DRINK AFTER 3:30 AM or

### THE DAY OF YOUR PROCEDURE:

- If you take insulin or oral diabetic medication, you are advised to HOLD and DO NOT TAKE on the day
  of your procedure. Bring it with you.
- Take any routine heart, blood pressure or seizure medications with a SMALL sip of water at least two
  hours before your procedure.

## YOU MUST HAVE WITH YOU:

- A responsible adult to drive you home. This individual must be present when you check-in and stay at the facility during the procedure or your procedure will be **CANCELLED**.
- A list of all medications you are now taking, including over-the-counter products and herbal supplements.
- A list of any allergies you have.
- If you have a Pacemaker/AICD please bring in your Pacemaker/AICD card.
